The program matches you with women professionals, or mentors, who volunteer their time to give you an inside look at where and how they work, the skills they use and some of their active projects. They also help you design a technology solution to a real-world problem if your group chooses.

Meet + Mentor at a Glance

How it Works

You're assigned to a mentoring group with 5-7 other students. Two mentors will work with your group after school, meeting with you online via Zoom until social distancing requirements are lifted and we're able to connect in person. You will be exposed to a wide range of women professionals who work in STEM-related careers across all disciplines and sectors and learn how they think and work. Your mentors will also take you on behind-the-scenes virtual office tours and field trips to tech companies. And then there's the design project—for added inspiration.

Eligibility Criteria

- Middle school girls aged 10-13 years old who are enthusiastic about STEM
- Able to make a 6-12 week commitment to group mentorship
- Can access at least one device with internet capabilities
- Communicate fluently and clearly in spoken and written English

Mentee Commitment

- Complete the online orientation.
- Submit an application with your interests and preferences.
- Participate in a 6-12 week online program under the guidance of co-mentors.
 - 90 minutes of career exposure and professional development every other week
 - 90 minutes of bi-weekly community building events with the entire program cohort
- Attend the year-end celebration and project showcase

Program Cost

There are two registration options:

- 1. Access to a single mentoring session is just \$15.00.
- 2. Our All Access Plan is \$150.00 and includes all 12 mentoring sessions, 2 mentee meetups (socials), a t-shirt, program materials, and sweet surprises each week! That's a \$30 saving.
