Talking Points





Welcome & Opening Remarks (10 minutes) Speaker: Host and/or Play Like a Girl Team Member

TALKING POINTS

- "Welcome, everyone! We're so excited to have you join us for this special Power Pack + Give Back event."
- "Play Like a Girl is a nonprofit that empowers middle school girls through sport and STEM to build confidence, curiosity, and leadership."
- "Today's volunteer activity may look simple—but it has powerful ripple effects. Each Power Pack you assemble will be delivered to a girl who may not otherwise have access to the supplies or support she needs to succeed."
- "You're not just packing kits—you're sending messages of possibility, hope, and resilience."



2 Icebreaker Activity (10 minutes) Speaker: Event Facilitator or Team Lead

TALKING POINTS

- "Before we get started, let's loosen up with a quick team icebreaker to connect and get energized."
- [Explain the selected activity: e.g., "Everyone pair up and play 'Human Bingo'—let's meet someone new!"]



Power Note Writing (15 minutes) Speaker: Event Facilitator or Team Lead

TALKING POINTS

- "These Power Packs are built by teams for girls who deserve to see what's possible when people work together."
- "We're going to begin by writing Power Notes—these are heartfelt messages of encouragement that will be included in each Power Pack."
- "Think about what you would have wanted to hear as a young girl (or guy) discovering who she is and what she's capable of."
- "Your words matter more than you know. These notes often become the part of the kit girls hold onto the longest."
- "A few prompts to get you started: 'You are...', 'Never stop...', 'Always believe that...'"



Power Pack Assembly (30-45 minutes) Speaker: Event Facilitator or Station Captain

TALKING POINTS

- "We're now ready to pack our Power Packs! Each of you will rotate through three packing stations: Art, STEM, Wellness."
- "Make sure every pack includes the correct items and a Power Note. Instructions are posted at each station."
- "Feel free to chat, enjoy the music, and make this fun—it's okay to get a little competitive too! Let's see how many kits we can assemble in 30 minutes."



5 Reflection & Closing Remarks (10 minutes) Speaker: Host and/or Play Like a Girl Staff Member

TALKING POINTS

- "Thank you all for the energy and care you brought to today's event. Together, you packed [insert number] Power Packs!"
- "These kits will go to girls in our programs—future coders, athletes, inventors, and leaders—who will know that someone out there believes in them."
- "We hope this experience reminded you of the difference a few kind words and a little teamwork can make."
- "Play Like a Girl is always looking for donors, sponsors, board members, mentors, and volunteers to join our mission—so let's keep the connection going!"
- "Please take a moment to complete a brief survey to provide us with valuable feedback about your experience volunteering with Play Like a Girl."



TALKING POINTS

- "Let's grab a photo with your team and the Power Packs you built—it's time to show off your impact!"
